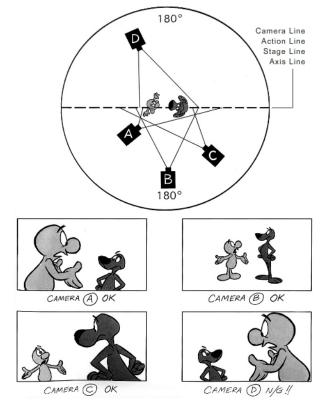
Things to keep in mind while storyboarding:

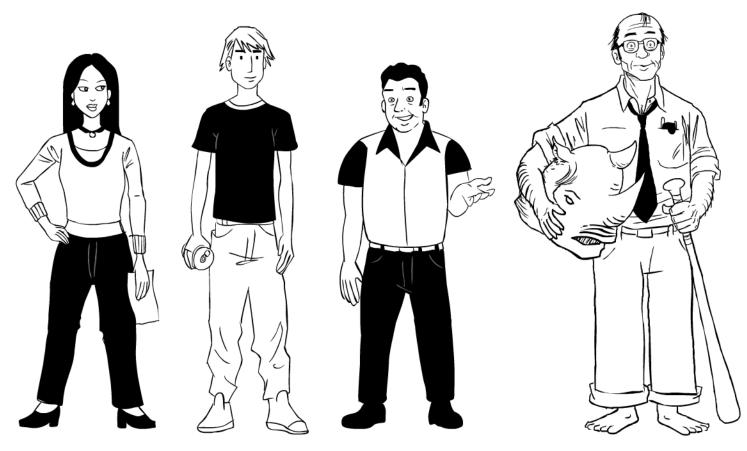
- -Camera Angles
- -Continuity (Cuts & Axis Lines)
- -Composition / Center of Attention
- -Close-ups, Medium Shots, Wide Shots (use them wisely)

Remember, the shots tell the story. How you frame each scene can help to tell the story in an entertaining and direct way. Simplicity and clarity are key.

You should write down any stage direction notes, acting notes, and most importantly the **dialogue** of each character underneath all panels. **Label your scenes** and panels according to when the camera cuts. Everytime the camera cuts to a new shot - add to the scene number and start back to panel 1.

Separate all these pages so you can have the script, designs and boards all in front of you while you work. Have fun! Good luck!

Miller: I swear! The police are looking for him and everything.

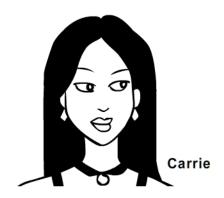
Pete: Y'know, I alwyas heard Mr. D was nuts. Did you guys know that last year, he was - - -
